ENGINEERING/COMPUTER SCIENCE (ECS) CONTINUING UNDERGRADUATE Application

DESCRIPTION

The Sacramento State Alumni Association Engineering and Computer Science Alumni Chapter awards one or more scholarships of \$500 annually to undergraduate students currently attending Sacramento State. Applicants need not be related to members of the ECS Chapter or Alumni Association.

The members of the ECS Chapter and Alumni Association value the education and experiences gained in their years at Sacramento State. These scholarships were created out of their desire to assist superior students to attend our great University. The expectation is that the recipient will contribute to the success of the University and will graduate to be a productive member of society and an active Alumni Association member.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

An applicant for selection of this award must:

- Have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better
- Be currently enrolled in a College of Engineering and Computer Science undergraduate program at Sac State (includes Mechanical, Civil, Electrical and Computer Engr, plus Construction Mgmt and Computer Science)

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Include the following items in the following order. DO NOT staple anything in your packet.

1. Completed General Application form with 'ECS Continuing Undergraduate Scholarship' checked
2. A one-page list of extracurricular activities and/or employment, awards and achievements for which you would like considered in scoring this application. (For example: student government, school clubs, science projects, volunteer activity, work experience.) Must include the date(s) of participation and any leadership roles held.
3. A personal essay/statement not to exceed two pages, 8.5 x 11 double spaced describing why you chose to attend Sacramento State, your degree and career goals, any hardships or obstacles you face in pursuit of your education at Sacramento State, and what you are doing to overcome those hardships.
4. Two letters of recommendation. One must be from a College of Engineering and Computer Science faculty member.
5. A copy of your transcripts or a print out of your Academic Record from MySacState through fall 2011.

DEADLINE: Send or deliver completed application to the following location by **Thursday, March 1, 2012.** Applications must be received or postmarked by the deadline, no exceptions:

APPLICATION REVIEW & RATING

A selection committee of alumni will review all complete applications and rate them on the basis of:

- The potential of the candidate to achieve academic success.
- Demonstrated leadership and participation and service in school and the community.
- Hardships and obstacles, financial or otherwise.
- Quality of the application received.
- Scholarship winners will be notified on or before May 1, 2012.
